## Ratios for School Field Trip Groups

We require a 1:5 chaperone to student ratio for Preschool through 2nd grade and 1:10 chaperone to student ratio for 3rd-12th grade. If necessary, with prior authorization, we will make reasonable accommodations to the ratios for students with special needs. Chaperones within the required ratios are admitted at no charge. These included chaperones need to be teachers, aides, and school staff. You may also bring parents as chaperones, if needed, to meet the ratios.
Additional parents above the ratios are welcome to join your group, but must pay the discounted adult rate of $\$ 25$ plus tax (total of $\$ 26.99$ ) each.

Ratios and included chaperones are for school groups. Homeschools need to pay for students and all adults, unless previous approval has been granted. Schools should have a minimum of 20 students, unless approval has been received from the Education Department.
